Mission


MRG Foundation's mission is to inspire people to work together for justice and mobilize resources for Oregon communities as they build collective power to change the world.

Background

- → Born in 1976 in Eugene
- → Three ideals:
 - Shift not just wealth, but also power to make decisions
 - Decision-making should be in the hands of those most impacted
 - Change, not charity
- → Funding comes from endowment and fundraising

What we fund

Eligibility

- → Be based in Oregon
- → Have 501(c)(3) tax exemption, have a 501(c)(3) fiscal sponsor, or engage in "charitable activities"
- → If current grantee, be current on grant reports
- → Not have an active grant

We don't fund

- → Direct service or social service agencies
- → Hospitals, colleges, schools, or co-ops
- → Animal welfare
- → Individuals or businesses
- → Lobbying
- → Illegal activities
- → Union organizing
- → Work that has already happened

Priorities

- → Community organizing, leadership development, collective action and/or other strategies that build power; and
- → Understand and are actively fighting **against systems of oppression**, violence and injustice; and
- → Intersectional lens; and
- → Addressing root causes, not just effects; and
- → Led by the **people most impacted**.

Grants

A bit of context

- → \$180,000 budget for this Spring
- → More than 100 applications expected
- → 15-20 applications funded
- → Amount range: \$6,000 to \$12,000

Amounts + Types

→ Operating Support

- ◆ 501(c)(3) exempt
- Annual budget under \$500,000
- ◆ Max amount \$15,000

Amounts + Types

→ Project Support

- 501(c)(3) or sponsored Max \$15,000
- Non-incorporated Max \$7,000



- → Basic information
- → Leadership demographics
- → Info re: grant request
- → Alignment with MRG
- → Budget info

Attachments

- → Required:
 - Budgets
- → Optional:
 - Additional materials
- → Later in the process:
 - Fiscal sponsorship agreements
 - Financials

Application Dos

- → Read materials and instructions carefully
- → Think about your audience
- → Be bold, be radical, be disruptive
- → Be realistic
- → Tell a story with your budget

Application Don'ts

- → Send us a full-length feature film. Please.
- → Worry about demographics
- → Wait until the last minute
